Although the kits have been on sale, we are waiting for the best price that will happen in a couple of weeks. Donations of money toward purchasing the kits would be greatly appreciated. We are aiming to pay about \$12 per kit. If you can help, please make a donation through the offering and mark it clearly, "Blankets for CWS." If you enjoy shopping and would rather pick up a kit or two and drop it off at the church, we'd gladly receive it. We want to have the kits by the end of August so that the youth can get started on the project. ### **Sanctuary Renovation Report**

Work on our Sanctuary is proceeding as scheduled and on budget. We are happy to report:

- Upgrades to the electrical lighting to LED systems, removal of antiquated wiring and the relocation of various electrical junction boxes for the application of insulation are complete.
- The process of installing spray-foam insulation was completed and a final inspection has been performed. Additional follow-up for minor inspection items will be completed very soon.
- Work has begun on the ceiling and walls in the Sanctuary. Removal of tiles, priming of surfaces and painting of trim are some of the tasks taking place. All work is on schedule.

As work continues through the summer, we ask that all of our members refrain from entering the Sanctuary during this remodeling phase. The safety of the workers and our members is our primary concern.

We ask our Congregation to continue praying for the successful completion of this project, the safety of the workers and our staff while work is being performed, and the timely return to worship in accordance with God's will for our Church.



# WELCA – School Kits



The Women of the ELCA of Grace will be assembling school kits for Lutheran World Relief on August 18 at 1:30 pm in the Library. Members of the congregation are welcome to help in this effort by putting donated items in the boxes in the gathering spaces marked "School Kits."

Items needed for the school kits are as follows:

- Four 70-sheet notebooks of wide or college-ruled paper approximately 8" x 10½"; **NO** LOOSE LEAF PAPER PLEASE
- One 30-centimeter ruler or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other
- One pencil sharpener
- One blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well)
- Five unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers; secure together with a rubber band
- One box of 16 or 24 crayons
- One 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" eraser
