

From Scripture, we can discern God's direction for our lives and our world. We can learn more about God, ourselves, and our relationship with others. Yet, how often do we pause long enough to hear the Holy Spirit speak to us through Scripture?

This Lent, you are invited to spend 4.5 hours in prayerful conversation around several passages of Scripture. If you come alone, you will find friends and fellow believers with whom to share conversation. If you come as a family, you will be strengthened as you develop a new level of conversation.
